

6th Annual High Bar Harbor Summer Charity Fluke Tournament August 6, 2011

Rules:

1. Entrance Fee \$50 per boat must be paid prior to August 4th. (all boats paid prior to August 1st will have boat name on official Tee Shirt).
2. Entrance Fee is for tournament prizes only. BBQ is an additional \$10.00 per person payable by August 1st or \$15.00 at the door.
3. NO more than 5 active anglers per boat.
4. Boats may not leave dock prior to 6:30 AM official start.
5. **All eligible fish must be in judges cooler by 1:30 PM (NO EXCEPTIONS)**
6. Non HBHYC boats may drop off fish to judge's cooler at the northeast corner of the yacht club dock between noon and 1:30 PM.
7. Non HBHYC boats may not enter the Marina without express permission from HBHYC.
8. **Weighing in will be at 3:00 PM** at the HBHYC Club house on their official digital scale supervised by the Marina Manager.
9. Raffles to be held immediately following weigh in.
10. BBQ starts at 1PM. \$10.00 per person in advance (by 8/1/11) \$15.00 at the door gets BBQ, pasta, salads, snacks, etc. beer and soda. Contestants and Non anglers are all invited to BBQ. Official Tee Shirts will be for sale.
11. Prizes are for top three fluke. (If less than three fish are reported drawing will determine winners). Only one fish per boat goes for the money – weigh in as many as you like but only one per boat goes for the prize money. Exception if less than three fish entered in entire contest then multiple fish from boats may be used until prize money is awarded. (If less than three boats have entered fish)
12. Prize money will be based on the entrance fees. 30% to first place, 20% to second place and 10 % to third place. All remaining proceeds go the Mercy Home Foundation, Inc.

13. Rain or Shine the tournament goes on. No Postponements
